



# HOHENSALZBURG FORTRESS

THE LANDMARK OF THE CITY OF MOZART



THE MAGNIFICENCE OF HOHENSALZBURG FORTRESS DOMINATES THE SCENERY FOR MILES AROUND AND REWARDS VISITORS WITH FANTASTIC VIEWS OF THE SPLENDOR OF A WORLD FAMOUS BAROQUE CITY AND THE STUNNING SURROUNDING ALPINE SCENERY. QUITE SIMPLY, IF YOU HAVEN'T VISITED THE FORTRESS – YOU HAVEN'T SEEN SALZBURG.



## FORTRESS TOUR – WITH AUDIOGUIDE

As part of this tour, visitors embark on a journey of discovery through one of the largest castles in Europe from the 11th century.

- Visits to the “Salzmagazin”, the torture chamber, the tower, the battlements and the “Salzburger Stier” with audio guide (11 languages)
- Individual tour of the Fortress museum, Marionette museum and Rainer Regiment museum
- Optional: visit the newly furnished State Rooms & Magic Theatre
- Roundtrip travel on the funicular

## CLASSIC FORTRESS TOURS

In this classic fortress tour, visitors learn interesting details about the construction history of the imposing fortifications and backgrounds of their creation. In addition, you can visit the Fortress museum, the Rainer Regiment museum and the Puppet museum as well as the unique State Rooms.

Ascent and descent by funicular is included

A) Personal guided through the interiors: the “Salzmagazin”, the torture chamber, the tower, the battlements and the “Salzburger Stier”

B) Personal guided tour of the outside areas of the fortress including the castle courtyards and bastions

This tour is a unique opportunity for visitors to climb down into the depths of the defences to reveal the secrets hidden below.

BAROQUE POWER - BAROQUE SPLENDOR



THE CATHEDRAL AND THE SALZBURG RESIDENZ PALACE FORM THE HISTORICAL CENTER OF THE CITY. EXPERIENCE 1300 YEARS OF POLITICAL POWER, ART AND CHURCH HISTORY THROUGH THE OVER 2000 RARE AND VALUABLE EXHIBITS AND THE UNMISTAKEABLE ARCHITECTURE OF THIS BUILDING COMPLEX WHICH IS UNIQUE IN EUROPE.



## TOUR DE BAROQUE

The complex of Residenz and cathedral, complemented by the Benedictine monastery of St. Peter, can be experienced as a continuous tour for the first time in 200 years, allowing an exciting historical walk through the former prince-archbishopric center of power with its varied history, unique architecture and important art treasures. Stunning views of the city included!

## MORE THAN A MUSEUM

The route passes through the state rooms of the Residenz to the Residenz gallery, through the northern arcade to the Cathedral and the Cathedral museum with its outstanding treasures. From there it continues on to the Cabinet of Curiosities, the Long Gallery and into the Wallstrakt, where in the Museum of St. Peter the most beautiful objects are shown from the rich art collection of the Abbey, and ends in the magnificent Carabinieri Hall of the Residenz. In addition to architectural masterpieces, lavishly furnished spaces and valuable art treasures, the DomQuartier offers a wealth of special tours, events and workshops as well as a colorful series of special exhibitions.



## WITH THE AUDIO GUIDE THROUGH THE DOMQUARTIER

For interested guests an audio guide in 9 languages is available for individual tours. With a specially developed by children for children audio guide our young guests are welcome to explore the DomQuartier on their own. 


## FROM THE BEGINNING – TO TOMORROW’S WORLD

The Haus der Natur Salzburg - Museum for natural science and technology - is a real crowd-puller. A tour of the museum reveals the full fascination of the natural world. At the entrance gigantic dinosaurs show how the world looked millions of years ago. Just a few steps away another section offers excitement in outer space and insights into the endless expanse of the universe. Our achievements in space travel bear witness to the age-old dream of mankind of making long journeys to faraway galaxies.

## SCIENCE CENTER: HANDS-ON TECHNOLOGY

Find hands-on, easy-to-understand physics and technology in the science center. There are almost endless opportunities to conduct experiments – to make electricity with turbines, glide through the air on a lifting platform, build a bridge and test it out. The science center offers lots of opportunities for active involvement.



## THE LIVING MUSEUM

THE LARGEST MUSEUM IN THE WHOLE OF THE PROVINCE OF SALZBURG IS SITUATED AT THE FOOT OF MOUNT UNTERSBERG AND FEATURES OVER 100 ORIGINAL HISTORICAL FARM BUILDINGS. GENUINE ARTEFACTS FROM SIX CENTURIES OF AGRICULTURAL LIFE, A NOSTALGIC 2KM RAILWAY, DEMONSTRATIONS OF OLD HANDICRAFT SKILLS AND AN ADVENTURE PLAYGROUND. COME AND SEE!



## FARMING LIFE IN YEARS GONE BY

A visit to the museum is like a journey through six centuries of life in the Province of Salzburg. Over one hundred original artefacts and buildings from all over the Province of Salzburg have been faithfully reassembled and furnished, including farmhouses and farmyards, mountain huts, blacksmiths workshops, mills, electric generators, creameries, breweries and many more. The oldest buildings date back to the 15th century. All the buildings are set in a natural environment and connected by a network of romantic walking paths.

## OUT AND ABOUT WITH THE MUSEUM RAILWAY

A 2 km narrow-gauge railway winds its way around the 50 hectares of the open air museum and runs the whole day. The museum train ride provides visitors with numerous interesting views of the museum grounds and the various buildings. There are 3 station stops around the grounds. Your physical well-being will also be catered to. The cosy museum inn with its large outdoor dining area is centrally located on the museum grounds and even has its own train stop!



## FARM GARDENS, NATURAL KNEIPP FOOTBATH, VINTAGE TRACTORS

The eleven farm gardens cultivated by the museum gardeners are a pleasure to behold – with typical herbs, flowers and vegetables cultivated as they were in the past. Guests can cool off in the wonderful natural Kneipp footbaths. Exhibitions on several themes and an interactive vintage tractor show highlight various aspects of farming history in Salzburg.

# HOHENWERFEN FORTRESS

AN AERIAL EXPERIENCE



THIS IMPOSING FORTRESS ALSO HOUSES A HISTORICAL FALCONRY CENTER AND GIVES GUESTS A PROFOUND VIEW OF LIFE IN THE 11TH CENTURY. FANTASTIC EXPERIENCES CAN BE FOUND IN THE TORTURE CHAMBERS AND ARMORY AND ON A VISIT TO THE AMAZING BIRDS OF PREY FLIGHT DEMONSTRATIONS.



## CLASSIC CASTLE TOUR

Personal tours provide visitors with deep insights into the eventful history of Hohenwerfen castle. One highlight of the visit is the demonstration of how to handle birds of prey staged by the historical 'Landesfalkenhof'.

- Personal tour of the chapel, torture chamber, battlements, bell tower, etc.
- Birds of prey flight demonstrations: falcons, buzzards, eagles and vultures (11:15 am and 3:15 pm, 17 July–18 August at 11:15 am, 2:15 pm and 4:30 pm)

- Tour of the large weaponry exhibition in the armory  
»From swords to rifles«

## THE SILENT PRISONER / SCHINDER BÄRBEI'S STORY

(starting at 4:15 pm)

These thematically specialized tours reveal to visitors the dark and secret corners of the castle: Josef Steinwender – the silent prisoner – tells of his 22-year incarceration in Hohenwerfen castle. Schinder Bärbel, mother of »Jackl the Sorcerer«, was suspected of being a witch, persecuted and imprisoned and also tells her story.

# EISRIESENWELT ICE CAVE WERFEN

INTO THE UNDERWORLD



SALZBURG IS MORE THAN JUST A MOUNTAINOUS REGION. THERE ARE ALSO NUMEROUS CAVES LIKE THE WORLD'S LARGEST ICE CAVE. THOSE WHO PEER INSIDE CAN SEE ROCK FORMATIONS THAT ARE MILLIONS OF YEARS OLD, GIGANTIC ICE SCULPTURES IN ALL IMAGINABLE SHAPES AND GLITTERING GROUPS OF CRYSTALS. WELCOME TO YOUR UNDERWORLD ADVENTURE.

## LARGEST ICE CAVE IN THE WORLD

This cave system was created by water flowing under the ground millions of years ago and later conquered by ice. It is unique the world over in every respect.

## FACTS, FIGURES AND ITEMS OF INTEREST

Giant chambers alternate with narrow passageways, small figures of ice with powerful sculptures of gigantic proportions. Water from thawing ice drips down in the spring, only to freeze in the cave and remain frozen, even at the height of summer. Almost the entire area on the tour is covered in ice.

- 40-kilometer cave system – 1 km open to visitors
- Tour with carbide lamps and extra-bright magnesium light
- Cave temperature 0°C – warm clothing and sturdy footwear recommended
- 20-minute walk from the visitor center to the base station for the cable car
- Ride on one of Austria's steepest cable cars
- Another 20-minute walk to the immense cave entrance at 1642 meters above sea level
- There is an altitude change of 134 meters (1400 steps) within the cavern
- All paths are secured by guardrails.
- Not suitable for the physically disabled or the frail!

From Werfen, approximately 40 kilometers south of Salzburg, a 5-kilometer mountain road leads up to a car park and visitor center at 1000 meters above sea level. The access road is open for coaches up to 14 meters long.
